EOP provides comprehensive student support services designed to enhance academic success, persistence, retention, student satisfaction, and graduation from SDSU. EOP has high expectations of its students; to ensure success you must work cooperatively with EOP to develop a personalized education plan.

As an EOP student you must make a commitment to the responsibilities outlined below:

1. EOP students are responsible for understanding the SDSU Catalog, which describes graduation requirements, academic policies, and procedures.
2. EOP students must participate in appropriate SDSU-EOP support programs. These may include First Contact, Academic Orientation, Fall Kick-Off, Summer Bridge, Learning Communities, SOAR EOP Mentor Program, academic workshops, probationary seminars, individual and group tutoring, and the EOP graduation celebration.
3. EOP students must keep updated personal contact information on the SDSU Web Portal.
4. EOP Freshmen students who are not exempt from the CSU Entry Level Math examination (ELM) and/or English Placement Test (EPT) must successfully earn credit in designated courses by the end of the summer term of enrollment after their first year or be subject to disenrollment from SDSU.
5. EOP Transfer students must take the Graduation Writing Assessment during the first semester at SDSU to be eligible to register for the second semester.
6. EOP students are required to meet with their EOP counselor twice per semester during the first academic year at SDSU and as prescribed by counselors thereafter.
7. EOP students on probation must complete the ACADEMIC SUCCESS CONTRACT with their EOP counselor prior to the 3<sup>rd</sup> week of the following semester and adhere to the guidelines stated on the contract. Failure to comply with these guidelines may result in the suspension of EOP services.
8. EOP full time students who have met program requirements may be eligible to receive an EOP grant.
9. EOP students should inform their EOP Counselor if they are participating in other SDSU support service programs.
10. EOP students are strongly encouraged to initiate contact with their professors and meet periodically with their faculty advisor.
11. EOP students are required to make an appointment for an exit interview with their EOP Counselor during their last semester of attendance at SDSU. On-line, get.....?
